I am writing to inform you about the arrangements for the last week of this academic term.

A number of trips and activities have been organised for each year group for either all or part of the week beginning 17 July.

Year 7 students will be in normal lessons on Monday and then will either be on the Bush Craft trip from Tuesday 18 – Thursday 20 July or will be taking part in Shakespeare workshops on Wednesday 19 and Thursday 20 July.

Year 8 students will be in normal lessons on Monday and Tuesday then take part in House activities in the following subjects:

- Art

- Computer science
- Photography
- Table tennis

These sessions will give students the opportunity to spend time developing their skills in an area they enjoy as well as taking part in a House competition.
