## **Dear Parents/Carers**

As we start the Summer Term, we want to take the opportunity to thank you for your ongoing support. Last term was particularly challenging with high levels of student and staff absence due to covid-19 infections and other illness.

The requirement for completing covid-19 LFD testing has now finished but we would encourage you to follow the most recent Government guidelines.

The NHS COVID-19 symptoms in adults and symptoms in children have been updated.

Adults and children who have symptoms of a respiratory infection, including COVID-19, should follow the <u>UKHSA guidance</u>. Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people, where they can. They can go back to school, college or childcare and resume normal activities when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend.

Additional guidance following the Living with COVID announcement, should also be followed.

UKHSA has now published new guidance for the general population on <u>reducing the spread of</u> <u>respiratory infections, including COVID-19, in the workplace</u>. This came into effect on Friday 1 April and is also relevant to education and childcare settings.

# Attendance and Uniform

Last term there was an increase in the number of students failing to follow the uniform guidance.
